REQUIREMENT

<p>CTP Content Specific Training Requirement</p>	<p>18 hours of content specific training, allocated as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Client Care in a Virtual Environment – 10 hours 2. Technology and Telepresence – 4 hours 3. Legal and Ethical Responsibilities in a Virtual Environment – 4 hours
<p>Supporting Documentation</p>	<p>Training documentation must provide the following information: Applicant Name; Title of Course/Training/Educational Event; Event Sponsor/Provider; Delivery Date(s); and Number of Contact or Credit Hours.</p> <p>If training certificates do not include all required information, contact the training provider and request additional information on their official letterhead to submit as documentation.</p> <p>If using college coursework for training credit, you must provide a copy of your transcript as well as a copy of the course description.</p> <p>Eligible training must be taken from an FCB Approved Education Provider within the last 5 years (no time limit on college coursework taken as part of a degree program).</p> <p>FCB Eligible Training Guidelines and Providers are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • College or university coursework offered by institutions holding Federal Department of Education and/or Council of Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) recognized accreditation. • Training providers approved to offer continuing education credits/hours by other state or national professional licensing or certification boards. • Agencies issued an FCB Approved Education and Training Provider number. • International Certification and Reciprocity Consortium (IC&RC) member board approved providers.

Technology and Telepresence (4 hours)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Overview of telehealth technologies • Hardware, software, portals, peripherals, platforms • Videoconferencing practices and procedures • Telepresentation skills • Setting the stage for appropriate telepresence (video, sound, lighting) • Use of specific telehealth modalities (mHealth, web-based tools, email, etc.) • Troubleshooting technical difficulties
